Additional informations:

The Faculty of Sociology, Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań, is located on the Szamarzewo Campus in the Ogrody district.

Using public transport, you can get to the Campus by trams 2, 17 or 18, going in the direction of Ogrody. To use public transport, you need to buy tickets: valid 45 minutes, which costs 5 PLN, or valid 24 hours, which costs 12 PLN. Tickets are available at vending machines at the stops. Trams stop at the loop. From there you walk to the Campus for about 5 minutes.

You can also get to the Campus by taxi or Uber. The cost of driving from the city center (near the Old Market Square) is about 15-20 PLN.
