Step-by-step Guide to apply for EPICUR Language and Culture Courses

Step 1:

Visit the EPICUR Virtual Campus (VCLP) https://learn.epicur.education/ as of 12 February 2021

Step 2:

Check whether you are eligible for an EPICUR mobility: are you enrolled in one of the eight EPICUR partner universities?

Step 3:

Register on the EPICUR VCLP by using your institutional email account from your home university (please note that registrations via other email accounts cannot be accepted)

Step 4:

Check and confirm that your application complies to the generic EPICUR admission criteria:

- 1. You are currently enrolled at an EPICUR partner university (you will be requested to upload proof of enrolment)
- 2. You have obtained a minimum of 60 ECTS of previous academic training (you will be requested to upload a transcript of records)
- 3. You have sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction of the course (you will be requested to upload either a certificate of an official language test or a signed statement by your current or previous institution confirming your proficiency)
- 4. You can clearly articulate your motivation to follow the course in a short statement (you will be asked to provide a written statement of maximum 250 words)

Step 5:

Choose and select one or more courses, *please note that for some courses additional admission criteria may apply!*

Step 6:

Apply online by clicking on the 'apply now' button on the VCLP. Please complete and upload the requested information and documentation in the EPICUR online application form. It is possible to save and reopen and your application form to complete it at a later time.

Step 7:

Submit your completed application online by 16 February 23:59 CET at the latest.

Step 8:

You will receive an email notice on the results of the review and selection procedure. If you will be offered a spot in one or more EPICUR Language & Culture courses, you will receive further information on how to access the courses by email.
